CLASS B DRIVER of VACUUM TRUCK – Chesapeake, VA

Responsibilities:

- Pick-up and delivery of hazardous and non-hazardous waste and materials.
- Maintain and operate 3,000 gallon vacuum truck as well as other equipment.
- Routinely perform pre- and post-trip inspections.
- Maintain driver's logs, properly placard vehicle, and prepare/complete manifests.
- Keep company vehicle clean and orderly, informing management of any safety concerns or vehicle problems.
- Comply with DOT, OSHA, EPA, and company regulations and policies.
- Maintain an acceptable driving record and meet all requirements to maintain a class B CDL.
- Secondary crew duties may include: pipeline pigging and pressure testing, demolition, and operating heavy equipment such as an excavator.

Qualifications:

- US Veteran, National Guardsman, Reservist, or Military Spouse (write your status on your resume)
- 1+ years of commercial driving experience and/or training.
- Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL); Tanker and HazMat endorsements are highly preferred.
- Able to work with varying levels of physical activities and physical extremes such as long periods of standing, walking, crouching, use of hands, and heavy lifting of up to 50 pounds or more.
- Able to work outside year round in all types of weather.
- Able work in environments that are extreme in nature like environmental conditions such as heat, cold, heights, dust/dirt, hazardous chemicals, loud noises, dangerous equipment, long hours etc.
- Must be clean shaven at all times to allow immediate donning and seal of respirator.
- Criminal background screening, Pre-employment drug screen, fit for duty physical including agility and DOT physical exam is required.
- Ability to obtain a security clearance
- Clean driving record.
- Travel around the region required. Will also require occasional out of town, overnight travel.
- Experience operating heavy equipment is a plus but not required.
- OSHA HAZWOPER 40-Hour training preferred (For a very qualified candidate, company would consider covering the training cost)
